We, Heyward Roberts Addison and William Harris Addison SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said Heyward Roberts Addison and William Harris Addison

in and by OUR certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of Three Thousand and No/100 (\$ 3,000.00 ) Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of Thirty and No/100 in advance
