George Coleman, his heirs and assigns forever:

"All that parcel, tract or lot of land, being in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, lying on south bank of Mountain Creek, branch waters of Enoree River, adjoining lands of W. P. Bull, and other lands of the grantor, and having the following metes and bounds:

"BEGINNING at corner post on southwest corner of Bridge over Mountain Creek on Rutherford Road, thence with said road S. $22\frac{1}{4}$ E. 8.64 chains to a point on east side of said road, thence S. 26-3/4 W. 9.59 chains to point on west side of road, thence S. 374 W. 8.24 chains to a point on west side of Rutherford Road, thence N. $15\frac{1}{4}$ E. 11.62 to a stone on west side old Rutherford Road, thence N. 61° 10° W. 5.45. chains to stone on steep hillside, thence S. 15 4 W. 8.64 chains to iron pin on north side of upland ditch, thence N. $65\frac{1}{8}$ W. 3.30 chains to iron pin on north side of ditch, thence N. 42 W. 5.55 chains to a point on west side of gully, thence N. 8 E. 2.93 chains to stone on west side of gully, thence N. 23 E, 2.75 to stone on east side of fish pond branch, thence N. $51\frac{1}{4}$ W. 2.75 to stone at pine, thence N. $20\frac{1}{2}$ E. 6.04 to a point on south bank of Mountain Creek, thence down the meanders of said creek to the beginning corner, and containing twenty-one and one-tenth acres, more or less, according to survey made by J.
