TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, Viola Marmaduke and Carolyn Hill Thomas SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said Viola Marmaduke and Carolyn Hill Thomas

in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of

TWO THOUSAND AND NO/100

(\$2,000.00 Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

TWENTY AND NO/100

(\$ 20.00 ) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said Viola Marmaduke and Carolyn Hill Thomas

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

the said Viola Marmaduke and Carolyn Hill Thomas in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville.

and in Greenville Township, just beyond the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 23 and 24 of the Hicks & Jackson Subdivision, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E", page 258, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northeast corner of Goodrich street and Hillcrest avenue (shown on plat as Cherry avenue), and running thence along the north side of said Hillcrest avenue, S. 46-41 E. 63 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 21 and 22; thence along the line of said lots, N. 43-19 E. 140.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 46-34 W. 87 feet to an iron pin on east side of Goodrich street; thence along the line of Goodrich street, S. 33-39 W. 142.4 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lots conveyed to Viola Marmaduke and A. S. Thomas by Nora W. Cooper and J. M. Wells as Guardians by deed dated June 9, 1930 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 177, page 56, and the undivided one-half interest of the said A. S. Thomas being conveyed to Carolyn Hill Thomas by deed dated Oct. 15, 1934 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 171, page 495, and also conveyed to us by Frank Cooper by deed dated April 06, 1935 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 180, page 84."
