TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Julian H. George, of Greenville County

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I the said Julia H. George

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of THIRTEEN HUNDRED AND NO/100

(\$ 1300.00 ) Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of THIRTEEN AND NO/100

(13.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Julian H. George

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me the said Julian H. George

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Paris Mountain Township, containing 1.44 acres, more or less, being on both sides of a County Road, running East from Parker Road, and having according to a survey made by W. A. Hester, June 15th, 1935, the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stone at the extreme Southeastern corner of a tract of land of P. E. Hudson, corner of land now or formerly owned by Crawley Foster, and running thence with the line of his property, N. 36 E. 4.04 chs. to a red oak, corner of property now or formerly owned by W. N. Miller; thence with the line of his property N. 33 W. 3.41 chs. to an iron pin, in line of property of P. E. Hudson; thence with the line of his property S. 36 W. 4.91 chs. to iron pin in line of property of Lizzie Burns; thence with the line of her property S. 48 E. 3.27 chs. to the beginning corner.
