"BEGINNING at a point on or near the National Highway, and running thence N. 83-26 E. 186 feet to stake; thence along line of Bleachery property, S. 4-17 W. 364.4 feet to an iron pin; thence along Southern Railroad right-of- way, N. 84-37 W. 165.4 feet to iron pin; thence along line of property formerly owned by Goudelock, N. 0-23 W. 285 feet to stake; thence N. 0-23 W. 38 feet to the beginning corner. This being the same property conveyed to Lillian Hudson by Mattie A. Raines, et al., Sept. 7, 1921 by deed recorded in Vol. 73, page 362, and by Alfred Taylor as Executor, Aug. 3rd, 1931 by deed recorded in Vol. 62, page 398; and conveyed to Citizens Bank of Taylors, by E.
