## DEED OF PARTIAL RELEASE

Being known and designated as the South 56.5 feet of Lots 3 and 5 of Section "G" per Plat recorded in Plat Book "A" at Page 337 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at a point on the eastern line of Bennett St; located S. 19 deg. 45' W. 150 feet from the southeast intersection of Bennett St. and Hast Earle St.; thence continuing S. 19 deg. 45' W. along the eastern line of Bennett St. 56.5 feet to a point (marked by an iron pin); thence S. 70 deg. 05' E. 120 feet to a point (marked by a post); thence N. 19 deg. 45' E. 56.5 feet to a point (marked by a post); and thence N. 70 deg. 05' W. 120 feet to the eastern side of Bennett St., the point of BEGINNING, it being the intention to release a portion of the premises described in the Deed of Trust aforesaid in which the courses vary by 1 deg. 15'.

TO HAVE AND to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Hattie Tansill her heirs and assings, forever freed, exonerated and discharged of and from the lien of said mortgage and every part thereof, provided always, nevertheless, that nothing herein contained shall in any wise affect, alter or diminish the lien or encumbrance of the aforesaid mortgage on the remaining part of said real estate, described in said mortgage, or the remedies at law for recovering from the said Hattie Tansill, her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, the balance of said principal sum, with interest, secured by said mortgage.
