and appoints his son, D. H. Marchant, Jr. and his daughter, Leila Marchant Smith, Executors.

NOW THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, D. H. Marchant, Jr. and Leila Marchant Smith, the duly appointed and qualified executors of the will of Daniel H. Marchant, late of Orangeburg County, pursuant to the direction and authorization contained in the above, do declare the mortgage of D. H. Marchant, Jr. to J. W. Norwood and assigned to D. H. Marchant, fully paid and satisfied, and the lien thereof fully discharged.
