Holland; thence with the line on the South side of the said last mentioned lot, N. 57-2/3 W. 171 feet to a stone; thence S. 21-3/4 W. 69 feet and 3 inches along a fifteen foot alley to a stake in the Northwest corner of Miss Hattie F.
