\_\_\_\_\_ annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, Greenville, County, State of South Carolina, and having the following courses and distances, according to a plat and survey of the property of the estate of Marion P. Hall, made by W. A. Hester, Surveyor on October 25, 1929, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I at page 147, and being designated on said plat as tract #2, containing 4.31 acres, more or less.

BEGINNING at an iron pin, joint corner of tracts Nos. 1 and 2 and running thence along joint line of said lots N. 27 E. 4.40 chs. to a W. O. Stump on branch; thence up the meanders of said branch 7.08 chs. to an iron pin; thence N. 70 W. 4.50 chs. to an iron pin, joint corner of tracts Nos. 2 and 3; thence along joint line of tracts #2 and 3 S. 27 W. 10.20 chs. to an iron pin, joint corner of tracts #2 and 3; thence S. 59 3/4 E. 4.10 chs. to the beginning corner.

Being a portion of the land inherited by the mortgagor from the estate of his father, Marion P. Hall, and deeded to him by J. L. Hall, et al by deed of even date herewith the same not yet having been recorded.
