The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

And having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the corner of Vance Street and Birnie Street and running thence with Vance Street, S. 15½ W. 200 feet to a stake corner of Lot No. 4; thence along line of Lot No. 4, N. 74 W. 150 feet to a stake on Woodside Mill line; thence along said Mill line, N. 15½ E. 200 feet to a stake on Birnie Street; thence along said Birnie Street S. 74 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 0, 1, 2 and 3 of Norwood Heights as shown on plat of J. N. Southern, D. S. October 1906 and recorded in Plat Book "A" at page 133 and being the same four lots of land conveyed to Charlie Dumit by J. A. Canup by deed dated November 18, 1931 and recorded in Deed Book, Vol. 160 at page 170.
