R. B. Gresham, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate and being in Grove Township, State and County aforesaid, containing sixty-three (63) acres more or less. Having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a Hickory tree on the line of Mrs. Cason's land and running thence S. 76.50 E. 11.80; thence S. 21 W. 5.78 to a stake; thence 51.50 E. 5.15 to a stake; thence N. 80.50 W. 26 to a stone; thence N. 4.50 W. 12 to an iron pin; thence N. 61 W. 9.00 to river bank; thence down the river bank 38.00 to a stone; thence N. 87.75 E. 7.90 to a stone; thence 5.61 E. 43.00 to a stake; thence N. 32.75 W. 13.84 to the beginning corner.
