Whereas, I the said W. C. Vess

in the full and just sum of Three Hundred Thirty-one and 40/100 (\$331.40)

(\$ ) Dollars to be paid Five and no/100 (\$5.00) each and every  
week beginning July 20, 1940 and Five and no/100 (\$5.00) Dollars each and every week thereafter  
until the total amount is paid in full.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, in the County and State aforesaid, on the National Highway, and being known and designated in the subdivision of the property of E. M. Wharton, as shown on a plat of record in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "B", at page 50, according to a survey made by R. E. Dalton in 1917, as Lot No. 34, and reference is hereby made to said plat.

The metes and bounds of said lot being as follows:
