"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

Gantt Township, and being a part of Tract No. 22 as shown on plat of property of E. A. Smyth et al., made by Dalton & Neves, Nov., 1935 and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Highway No. 29, joint corner of Tracts Nos. 21 and 22, and running thence N. 88-34 W. 596.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along right-of-way of C. & G. Division of Southern Railway as shown on said plat, N. 0-35 W. 150 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 23; thence along the line of Lot No. 23, S. 88-34 E. 300 feet, more or less, to the center of branch; thence in a Southernly direction through the center of said branch to an iron pin, which iron pin is 75 feet from the side line of said Lot No. 22; thence in a line parallel to said side line, S. 88-34 E. 275 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the Western side of said Highway No. 29, said iron pin being in the center front line of said Tract No. 22; thence along the west side of said Highway, S. 1-21 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner.

Subject, however, to a strip fifty feet wide at the rear claimed by the Southern Railway as a part of the right-of-way of said Southern Railway.
