TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Mrs. Florence Hillhouse, of Greenville, S. C.,

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I the said Mrs. Florence Hillhouse

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of

TWENTY THOUSAND AND NO/100

(\$20,000.00 Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

ONE HUNDRED, FORTY-SIX AND NO/100

(\$ 146.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said

C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

and in Ward One of the City of Greenville, on the south side of Buncombe Street and on the east side of Whitner street, and being more patricularly described as follows, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeast corner of the intersection of Buncombe Street and Whitner street, and running thence along the east side of said Whitner street in a southwesterly direction, 170 feet, more or less, to an iron pin where a 10-foot alley enters said Whitner st street; thence along the north side of said 10-foot alley in a southeasterly direction, 64.3 feet to an iron pin on said 10-foot alley, rear corner of Sarah B. Poe lot; thence along the line of said Poe lot, in a northeasterly direction, 145.1 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the south side of Buncombe Street; thence along the line of a strip sold to the City of Greenville by Mary B.
