all that tract or lot of land in **Bates** Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone on the Buncombe Road and running thence N. 32 E. 9.50 to a stake; thence N. 50 E. 14.15 to a stake in branch; thence along the meanders of the branch 26.50 to an iron pin in branch; thence S. 23 1/4 E. 15.25 to an iron pin; thence S. 38 W. 10.00 to an iron pin in the Buncombe Road; thence along the Buncombe Road 6.23 to the beginning corner, having such forms and shape as will appear by reference to a plat made by W. A. Hester from a survey made by him on Sept. 19, 1912, and according to said plat containing twenty eight (28) acres, more or less.
