(\$ 317.53) Dollars, to be paid on or before one year after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining land of Johnie Bridwell on the north, and other lands of M. D. Rice and Florida Rice, on the east side of a branch, waters of Enoree River, and having the following metes and bounds:
BEGINNING at a white oak on west side of said branch, thence down said branch as the line in the general direction of N. 21 1/2 E. 3.07 chains to a bend, thence with branch as the line in general direction of N. 64-3/4 W. 4.00 chains to a point in center of branch on L. E. Gaillard line, thence S. 41 3/4 E. 2.80 to iron pin on bank of a gully, thence along said gully S. 13 E. 46 of a chain to iron pin on bank of gully, thence S. 73 1/2 W. 6.97 chains to the beginning corner, and containing one and one-half (1 1/2) acres more or less, according to survey made by J.
