Those two lots of land conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master, December 16, 1942, by deed recorded in Book 249, at page 357; one of those lots fronting on Perry Avenue, the other on Doe Street, and having the rear line in common, the lots being described in said deed, but a better description is taken from a plat made by W. J. Riddle December 12, 1942, recorded in Plat Book N. P. 27, from which the following description is taken.

BEGINNING at a stake on the south side of Doe Street at the northern corner of W. G. Sirrine lot, and running thence his line S 23-20 W 96 feet to a stake; thence the southern line of the Sirrine lot S 66-40 E. 45 feet to a stake in the line of Dr. J. W. Clatworthy; thence along the Clatworthy line S 23-20 W 96 feet to an iron pin in the line of Perry Avenue; thence along the line of said Avenue N 66-40 W 70 feet to a stake; thence N 23-20 E. 192 feet to a stake on the south side of Doe Street; thence the south side of said street S 66-40 E 25 feet to the beginning corner.
