on the north side of Arlington Avenue in the Town of Greer, known as Lot No. 6 on a plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 299, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the north side of Arlington Avenue, corner of Lot No. 1, 175 ft. east from Broad or Mostella Street, and running thence with lines of Lots Nos. 1, 2, and 3, in a Northerly direction 175 feet to corner of Lot No. 8; thence with the line of Lot No. 8 in an easterly direction 64 feet to corner of Lot No. 7; thence with the line of No. 7, in a Southerly direction 175 ft. to Arlington Avenue; thence with the Northern side of Arlington Avenue in a Easterly direction 64 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to W. T. Mitchell by deed dated January 30, 1915, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "25" at page 571.
