all that tract or lot of land in **Chick Springs** Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as a part of the land conveyed to James Davis by deed from M. Turpin, adjoining lands of J. B. Davis, Beginning on the South side of the Road leading from Chick Springs Road to Paris Mountain Road on an iron pin; thence running S. 7 W. 2.03 chs. to an iron pin; thence S. 77 E. 1.26 chs. to an iron pin; thence N. 36 E. 1.74 chs. to iron pin on Road; thence with Road N. 65 W. 2.17 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing 3/10th of an acre, more or less; being the same lot conveyed to the mortgagor by J.
