with interest thereon from

six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly

interest at same rate per month, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, or should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness, attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Ward one of the City of Greenville, on the northeast side of Hampton avenue, and having the following boundaries,

BEGINNING at an oak fence post on Hampton avenue at the corner of the lot now or formerly belonging to W. T. Pitman, which point is 109 feet from the northeast corner of the intersection of Hampton avenue and Academy street, and running thence N. 10-15 E. 101 ft., 6 inches to an oak post; thence N. 24-30 E. 60 feet to a corner on line of lot of T. G. Smith; thence N. 50-30 W. 51 feet, 3 inches to an oak post in fence corner; thence S. 24-31 W. 61 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 42 W. 99 feet, 6 inches to an oak post on the northeast side of Hampton avenue; thence with Hampton avenue, S. 48-50 E. 55 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Ruby D. Cooper by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded.
