(showing land formerly belonging to Julius G. Smith), filed in the office of the Clerk of Court for said County and State in Judgment Roll #A-445; the portion of said Lot intended to be conveyed hereby having according to said Plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the West side of N. Main Street, approximately 120 feet Southward from the South side of College Street (said stake being on the Northeast corner of Lot No. 3 as shown in said Plat formerly belonging to Frank C. Owens, then to H. Endel, and now to W. H. Keith) and running thence along the Keith line N. 72 W. 130 feet, more or less, to a stake on Alley; thence along said Alley N. 18 E. 40 feet to a stake on corner of Lot formerly owned by Alexander McBeth; thence with line of last mentioned Lot S. 72 E. (parallel with the Keith line) 130 feet, more or less, to a stake on Main Street; thence along said Street S. 18 W. 40 feet to the beginning corner.
