Said lots together have a frontage of 100 feet on the Old Paris Mountain Road and a depth of approximately 150 feet, and are a part of the land which was formerly conveyed to us by E. Inman, Master by deed recorded in Deed Book 149, Pages 366 and 367, and lot 5 having been conveyed to us by R. Z. Young and Louise Young by deed recorded in Deed Book 167, Page 353.
