

BEGINNING at a point, corner of lot No. 14 on said plat, and runs thence with the line of lot 14 205 feet to the corner of lot No. 3; thence with the line of lot No. 3 60 feet to the corner of lot No. 16; thence with lot 16 192.8 feet to a street; thence with said street to the beginning, and being all of that lot conveyed to the late R. D. Dobson by deed which is on record in the R. M. C. Office for said County in Deed Book 8-F, at page 548.

Also, all of that other lot of land, with improvements thereon, in Beech Springs Township of Spartanburg County, near the Town of Greer, on the North side of Rose Street, being all of lot No. 1 in Block A on a plat of land known as Dillworth Park, said plat being on record in the R. M. C. Office for Spartanburg, reference to the record of same being hereby made for a more particular and definite description of said lot. This is the same lot conveyed to the late R. D. Dobson by deed which is on record in said R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 6-0, at page 686.

Also, all of that other parcel or lot of land situate in Beech Springs Township of Spartanburg County, S. C., near the Town of Greer, being all of lot No. 16 in Block A on a plat of property known as Dillworth Park, having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING at a point on an unnamed street, corner of lot No. 15 and runs thence along line of lot No. 15 192.8 feet to the corner of lot No. 2; thence along back line of lot No. 2 60 feet to corner of lot No. 17; thence with line of lot No. 17 180.5 feet to a stake; thence along said unnamed street to the beginning corner. This is the same lot of land conveyed to the late R. D. Dobson by LeRoy, Master, by deed which is on record in the R. M. C. Office for Spartanburg County in Deed Book 7-T, at page 451.

Also, all of that other lot of land, with improvements thereon, situate in Beech Springs Township of Spartanburg, S. C., near the Town of Greer, lying on the North side of Church Street, and being all of lot No. 19 as shown on a plat of land known as Sunny Side, the same being on record in Plat Book No. 4, at page 91, in the R. M. C. Office for Spartanburg County, reference to said plat being made for a more particular description of said lot. This is the identical lot conveyed to the late R. D. Dobson by LeRoy Moore, Master, by deed which is recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 7-T, at page 628.

Also, all of those lots of land situate in Spartanburg County, in Beech Springs Township, near the Town of Greer, being all of lots Nos. 46 and 47 on a plat of land known as Beasley Addition for colored people, lying on the East side of the Victor-Apalache Road, having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Prince Street, and runs thence N. 3.30 E. 100 feet; thence S. 75.45 E. 57.7 feet; thence S. 3.30 W. 100 feet to Prince Street; thence N. 75.40 W. 49.1 feet to the beginning corner, and being the identical property conveyed to the late R. D. Dobson by deed which is on record in the R. M. C. Office for Spartanburg County in Deed Book 7-X, at page 590.

Also, all of those other lots of land, with improvements thereon, in Beech Springs Township, of Spartanburg County, S. C., near the town of Greer, lying on the South side of the Victor-Apalache Road, being all of lots Nos. 22, 23, 40 and 41 on a plat of land known as Beasley Addition for colored people. Lots 40 and 41 fronting 25 feet each on Price Street and lots Nos. 22 and 23 lying directly back of them and fronting 25 feet each on Bomar Street. These are the same lots conveyed to the late R. D. Dobson by deed which is on record in the R. M. C. Office for Spartanburg County in Deed Book 7-L, at page 331.

Also, all of those other lots of land situate in Beech Springs Township of Spartanburg County, S. C., lying just East from the incorporate limits of the Town of Greer, together with all improvements thereon, being all of lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, as shown on a plat of property of the R. D. Dobson Estate made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, May 20, 1936, and having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on an iron pin on Oak Street, the northwestern corner of lot No. 4, and runs thence with the East side of another street N. 9.15 E. 226.7 feet to an iron pin at intersection with a street not yet opened; thence with the South side of unopened street S. 71.00 E. 329.2 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Victor-Apalache Road; thence with the West side of said road S. 18.30 W. 68.1 feet; thence S. 37.13 W. 80 feet; thence S. 42.27 W. 106.2 feet to a stake at intersection of Victor-Apalache Road with Oak Street; thence with the North side of Oak Street N. 66.23 W. 226.3 feet to the beginning corner, and being that property conveyed to the late R. D. Dobson by W. P. and J. A. Center, by deed which is on record in the R. M. C. Office for Spartanburg County in Deed Book 6-M, at page 154, a portion of same being later re-conveyed to R. D. Dobson's Executors by deed recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 8-S, at page 316.

Also, all of that other parcel or lot of land situate and being in Beech Springs Township, of Spartanburg County, S. C., near the Town of Greer, lying on the west side of the Victor-Apalache Road, having a five-room dwelling thereon, with the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on an iron pin at North edge of an unopened street, the southwestern corner of said lot, and runs thence with North side of said unopened street S. 71 E. 164.2 feet
