in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to ~~us~~ us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Frank H. Earle, all our right, title and interest, the same being an undivided half interest in and to

all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. and in the City of Greenville

BEGINNING at corner of John Moore's lot (or formerly John Moore) on North Street; thence with North Street S. 72 1/2 W. 50 feet to corner of the Ligon lot; thence S. 25 W. with Ligon line N. 25 W. 100 feet to a pin; thence N. 72 1/2 E. 43 feet and 9 inches to pin on the Moore line; thence with Moore line S. 28 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same land conveyed to Clara Snead by Home Building and Loan Association, deed dated November 1913, and recorded in Deed Book 16, Page 353. Our mother, Clara Snead died intestate leaving as her sole heirs, six children, and we acquired the interest of Elloit Snead our brother, and do hereby mortgage our undivided one-half interest in said land.
