Dalton, Engineer, in March, 1923 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, pages 114-115, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the south side of Byrd Boulevard at joint corner of Lots 147 and 148, said stake being 1264.7 feet in an easterly direction from the southeast corner of the intersect of Byrd Boulevard with Augusta Road and running thence with the south side of Byrd Boulevard S 60-28 E 140 feet to a stake at corner of lot No. 145; thence along line of said Lot No. 145 S 29-32 W 300 feet to a stake in line of lot No. 117; thence N 60-28 W. 140 feet to a stake at rear corner of Lot No. 148; thence along line of said lot No. 148 N 29-32 E 300 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same land conveyed to the Mortgagor by E. F. Anderson by deed of even date herewith, to be recorded.
