Whereas, we, W. B. Thompson, M.A. Thompson, J.W. Thompson, James S. Briggs, and Frances G. Briggs are indebted to The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, South Caroline, in the sum of Forty-eight thousand dollars, evidenced by our note of this date for the amount of Forty-eight thousand dollars, due and payable as follows: Four thousand dollars January 1, 1946 and four thousand dollars on the first of each successive month thereafter until paid in full, with interest from date on the unpaid principal at the rate of four per cent. payable monthly.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to us in hand paid by The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, South Carolina, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in order to carry out the intention expressed in the premises, we hath given, granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, assign and convey unto The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, South Carolina, and its successors and assigns, the following described land, to-wit:

(1) All that contain piece, parcel or tract of land the te, lying and being in Oaklawn of Reedy River, containing Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on 73.4 acres as shown on plat of property of Virginia Walling prepared by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineers, September 23, 1937 o said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
