Allison and containing 96 acres, more or less, bounded on the north by lot number 5 of the R. B. Allison estate and by the Davenport lands, on the east by lot number 3 of the R. B. Allison estate, on the south by the Cobb lands, and on the west by lot number 1 of the R. B. Allison estate. The tract of land is specifically described by courses and distances on plat made by Wm. F. Lee Surveyor, in August 1917, and reference is thereto made for a more definite and positive description, said plat being recorded in book _____ page _____, Greenville County Records.
