Beginning at a stone on Hattie Speegals line, thence N. 5 E 18.25 chains to stone in branch; thence down said branch N. 25 1/2 W. 4.40 chains to a box elder on right bank of Wiers Creek; thence N. 8 1/2 W. 32.00 chains to stone; thence S. 80 1/2 W. 17.06 chains to stone; thence S. 2 E. 13.60 chains to stone (formerly a poplar); thence down a branch as a line 17.20 chains to Wiers Creek; thence down said creek about 5.00 chains to stone on left bank of creek; thence S. 21 E. 8.00 chains to stone; thence S. 22 E. 4.50 chains to a sowerwood; thence S. 59 1/2 E. 9.20 chains to stone; thence S. 84 E. 5.00 chains to stone; thence S. 58 E. 3.10 chains to beginning, containing 82 acres, more or less, adjoining lands Hattie Speegal and others.
