(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:



NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All-the certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, at the Northwestern corner of Welcome Avenue and Mary Street near the City of Greenville, shown as Lots No. 117 am Map No. 2 of Camilla Park made by W. J. Riddle in December, 1943, recorded in Plat Book M at Page 85 and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Northwestern corner of Welcome Avenue and Mary Street and running thence with the Northern side of Welcome Avenue, S. 59-30 W. 150 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 86; thence with the lines of Lots Nos. 86, 87 and 88, N. 6-42 W. 205.5 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 116; thence with the line of said Lot, S. 87-52 E. 187 feet to a stake on Mary Street; thence with the Western side of Mary Street, S. 2-08 W. 76 feet to a stake; thence continuing with Mary Street, S. 35-18 W. 53.6 feet to the beginning corner."

Said premises being one of the lots conveyed to the mortgager by C. P. Hunt by deed dated November 29, 1945, recorded in Book of Deeds 283 at Page 317.
