We, John C. Nagle and Ann Shaw Nagle, of Greenville, S. C., SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS we the said John C. Nagle and Ann Shaw Nagle

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to

C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township on the north side of Club Drive, and being known and designated as Lot No. 45, of the property of Razor & Ables, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, at page 153, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Club Drive, joint corner of Lots 45 and 46, which point is approximately 399 feet west from the northwest corner of the intersection of Club Drive and Ridge Drive, and running thence along the line of Lots Nos. 45 and 46, in a north-westerly direction 178.9 feet to an iron pin; thence in a southwesterly direction 76.5 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 44 and 45; thence along the joint line of said lots, in a southeasterly direction, 177.7 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Club Drive; thence along the line of said Club Drive, in a northeasterly direction, 79 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land in which Ann Shaw Nagle conveyed an undivided one-half interest to John C. Nagle, by unrecorded deed, and which was conveyed to the said Ann Shaw Nagle by the Fidelity Federal Savings and Loan Association by deed dated May 6, 1940 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 221, page 308."
