(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:



NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, together with all improvements thereon, containing 2 acres, more or less, on the North side of the Lee Road, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Lee Road, at the corner of property now or formerly owned by Rethie McKinney, and running thence along the line of said property. N. 16-13 E. 209.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-48 E. 285.4 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of property now or formerly of Finley, N. 34-00 W. 480 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 20 W. 515 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the North side of Lee Road; thence along the North side of Lee Road, S. 73-42 E. 115.3 feet to the point of beginning."

Reserving, however, an easement or right-of-way in favor of J. D. Robins and his heirs and assigns, over a strip 15 feet wide immediately east of the western boundary line of said property for the use of a road way extending from Lee Road.
