NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That it, the said Central healty corporation in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aferesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Lower Main Street Bank, according to the condition of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to it the said Central Realty Corporation in hand well and truly paid by the said The Lower Main Street Bank at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents and receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents to grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Lower Main Street Eank:
