MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, William R. Merritt
..... (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Six Thousand and No/100 -----
DOLLARS (\$ 6,000.00 -----), with interest thereon from date at the rate of four (4%) ----- per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, near the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 53, in Block D of the subdivision known as Augusta Court as shown on plat of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at Page 124, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Augusta Court, joint corner of Lots Nos. 52 and 53, and running thence S. 49-15 W. 177 feet to an iron pin on Lot No. 70; thence with joint line of Lots Nos. 53 and 70, N. 39-26 W. 78 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 53 and 54; thence with joint line of Lots Nos. 53 and 54, N. 51-20 E. 177 feet to an iron pin on Augusta Court; thence with the line of Augusta Court, S. 39-33 E. 71.7 feet to the beginning corner."

Said premises being the same conveyed to William R. Merritt and Catherine F. Merritt by deed of Fred M. McPherson, et al dated April 6, 1946, recorded in Volume 259 at Page 495; Catherine F. Merritt having conveyed her one-half interest therein by deed to be recorded herewith.
