situate, lying and being on the New Buncombe Road, and containing one acre, more or less, near the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds according to a survey and Plat made by W. J. Riddle on May 24, 1939;

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of the New Buncombe Road and Hammett Street, and running thence with the curve of Hammett Street in an easterly direction 7.9 feet; thence still with Hammett Street, N. 48-30 E. 216.6 feet to an alley; thence with the alley, N. 5-20 W. 203.5 feet; thence S. 86-25 W. 144.5 feet to an iron pin on the New Buncombe Road; thence with the said road S. 2-10 W. 338.5 feet to the beginning corner, and being all of Lots Nos. 134 and 136, and a portion of Lot No. 132 of the property of the H. P. Hammett Estate.

Said property is the same conveyed to W. A. Bull and Henry P. Willimon by deed of Harold C. Berger, et al, by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Book of Deeds 292 at Page 15.
