MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, that the mortgager, for the better securing the payment to the said mortgagee of the said sum of money mentioned in said note or obligation, with interest thereon, and also for and in consideration of the sum of one policy to the mortgager in hand paid by the mortgagee, the receipt whereon is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate and being on the West side of Ponce DeLeon Drive near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known as Lot 5 on plat of Lanneau Prive, Highlands, made by Dalton & Neves, Enganeers, August, 1937, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "D", at pages 288 and 289, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bouths, po-wit:-
