TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Mendel L. Fowler

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the north side of Paris Mountain Avenue, and being known
