all that ~~tract or~~ lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the north side of Julian Street, near the City of Greenville, being known as Lot No. 29 on Plat of Subdivision known as Queen Heights made by N. O. McDowell, Jr., and J. P. Moore, November 1944, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book O, at Page 87, and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Julian Street at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 29 and 30, said pin also being 210 feet west from the northwest corner of the intersection of Julian Street and Queen Street, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 30, N. 21-45 E. 116 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 9, N. 68-43 W. 40 feet to an iron pin (thence with the line of Lot No. 28 S. 21-45 W. 115 feet to an iron pin) on the north side of Julian Street; thence with the north side of Julian Street, S. 67-39 E. 40 feet to the beginning corner.
