

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Oscar W. Shockley, of Greenville County SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I, Oscar W. Shockley

in and by my Oscar W. Shockley certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of EIGHT THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED AND NO/100

four (4%) Dollars, with interest at the rate of 1/4 (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of FIFTY-TWO AND NO/100

(\$52.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Oscar W. Shockley

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

the said Oscar W. Shockley

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, on the southeast side of Bates Street Extension (or Furman Road), and being known and designated as Lot No. 11 of a subdivision known as Sans Souci Highlands, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book G, at page 126, and on revised plat recorded in Plat Book L, at page 173, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Bates Street Extension (also known as Furman Road), at the corner of Lot No. 10, which point is 215 feet south of the intersection of Eldendale Avenue with Bates Street Extension, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 10, S. 54-00 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence along the line of said alley, S. 28-30 W. 50 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 12; thence along the line of said Lot No. 12, N. 55-30 W. 166 feet to an iron pin on Bates Street Extension; thence along the line of said street, N. 32-33 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner." Being the same lot conveyed to me by Caroline B. Moseley by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded.
