full, with privilege of making additional payment or paying in full on any interest date,

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annual

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to
