TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, J. R. McAbee

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, about two and one-half miles Southwest from the Greenville

County Courthouse, on the Northern side of Waco Street, being shown as Lot No. 9 in the subdivision of the property of J. R. West which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at Page 190 and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Waco Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 10, N. 16-34 W. 144 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 83-44 W. 60.2 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 8; thence with the line of Lot No. 8, S. 16-34 E. 148.5 feet to an iron pin on Waco Street; thence with the Northern side of Waco Street, N. 75-02 E. 60 feet to the point of beginning."
