MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Helen Pettett Dixon

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Seventy-two Hundred and No/100

DOLLARS (\$ 7,200.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five & one-half per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, on the Eastern side of McDonald Street, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 84 on Plat of North Hills, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, April 1925, recorded in Plat Book H at Page 138, and having, according to said Plat, and a survey by A. Newton Stall, October 7, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at a stake on the East side of McDonald Street, at joint corner of Lots Nos. 84 and 85, 552.7 feet North from Gallivan Avenue, and running thence with the East side of McDonald Street, N. 23-32 E. 70.2 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 83 and 84; thence with the line of Lot No. 83, S. 71-43 E. 192.3 feet to an iron pin on the West side of a 20-foot alley; thence with the west side of said alley, S. 18-34 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 85 N. 71-43 W. 198.3 feet to an iron pin on the East side of McDonald Street, the beginning corner."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by Mary P. Rumsey by deed recorded Book of Deeds 276 at Page 37.
