MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Wallace Riley Cordell,
..... (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of THIRTY-FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 -----
DOLLARS (\$ 3,500.00 -----), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five and one-half per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of Washington Avenue, near the City of Greenville, being the northern portion of Lot No. 12, and Lots Nos. 11, 10, and the Southern portion of Lot No. 9, as shown on plat of Camilla Park, Map No. 1, by Dalton & Neves, in Dec., 1927, and recorded in Plat Book G, at page 225, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Washington Avenue, 105 feet south from Flora Avenue, and running thence S. 67-48 W. 222.8 feet to a stake on an Alley; thence with the Eastern side of said Alley, S. 21-27 E. 225 feet to a stake; thence N. 67-48 E. 224.7 feet to Washington Avenue; thence with the Western side of Washington Avenue, N. 21-55 W. 225 feet to the beginning corner.
