Whereas, I the said James H. Coleman

in the full and just sum of Two Thousand and No/100 - - - - -
(\$ 2,000.00.) Dollars, to be paid as therein stated

with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-
annually - - - - -

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate about four miles Northwest from Greer and about two miles South from Double Springs Baptist Church, lying at the Southwest intersection of the Buncombe Road and the Old Rutherford Road, being all of tract No. 6 on a plat of property made for the J.B. Brookshire Estate by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated September 23, 1946, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "P", at Page 89, reference to which is hereby made for a detailed and complete description of said tract. Said tract has the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stake at the intersection of the aforesaid roads, and runs thence with the South side of Buncombe Road N. 61.30 W. 275 feet to a stake, corner of tract No. 5; thence with line of tract No. 5 300 feet to a stake on line of tract No. 21; thence with line of tract No. 21 S. 61.30 E. 175 feet to a stake on the West side of the Old Rutherford Road; thence with the West side of said road in a Northeastwardly direction 312 feet to the beginning corner, containing one and 55/100 acres, more or less.
