Bayne to The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, securing the payment of the principal sum of Twenty-Two Hundred - - - (\$2200.00 Dollars, dated the - 26 - day of - March - 1947, and recorded in the public records for Greenville County, State of South Carolina in Mortgage Book 361, at page 65, the property hereinafter described : and Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, the owner and holder of the security instrument hereinafter referred to and of the note thereby secured, pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation Act (Sec. 1020b, Title 12, U.S.C.), by and through the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as its Agent and Attorney in fact pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Farm Credit Act of 1935(Sec. 1016h, Title 12, U.S.C.) does, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, hereby release and forever discharge from the lien of that certain security instrument executed and delivered by Fred S. All that certain parcel or tract of land containing one(1) acre, more or less, in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, more particularly described according to a survey and plat made by E. E. Gary, Surveyor, dated April 12, 1947, as follows: BEGINNING at the center of the Bennett's Bridge Road where it crosses the South boundary of the property described in said security instruments and runs along the line of E. J. McDonald North 72 degrees 45 minutes East 6.83 chains to an iron pin: thence North 34 degrees 30 minutes West 2.12 chains to the center of said road; thence along said road South 54 degrees 45 minutes West 6.64 chains to the point of beginning.
