until paid in full, and interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the South side of East McBee Avenue, in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, having the following measurements:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of East McBee Avenue, at an alley, and runs thence with said East McBee in an eastern direction 41 feet to a pin; thence in a southern direction 50 feet to a pin; thence west 71 feet to a pin on an alley; thence with said alley 70 feet to the beginning corner.
