"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as lot # 13, Block A, as shown on Map of Augusta Court, recorded in Plat Book F, at Page 124, and being more particularly described, according to said Plat, as follows:
