Whereas Samuel Lurey

is justly indebted to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagee, in the sum of Ten Thousand

(\$ 10,000.00), lawful money of the United States which shall be legal tender in payment of all debts and dues, public and private, at the time of payment, secured to be paid by that one certain bond or obligation, bearing even date herewith, conditioned for payment at the principal office of the said C. Douglas Wilson & Co., in the City of Greenville, S. C., or at such other place either within or without the State of South Carolina, as the owner of this obligation may from time to time designate, of the sum of

Ten Thousand & no/100 - - - - -

with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of 4 1/2 per centum per annum, said interest to be paid on the 1st day of March 19 48 and thereafter said interest

and principal sum to be paid in installments as follows: Beginning on the 1st day of April 19 48, and on the 1st day of each month thereafter the sum of \$ 63.27

to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 1st day of February 19 68 and the balance of said principal sum to be due and payable on the 1st day of March 19 68;

the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 63.27 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of 4 1/2 per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 10,000.00 or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal. Said principal and interest to be paid at the par of exchange and net to the obligee, it being thereby expressly agreed that the whole of the said principal sum shall become due after default in the payment of interest, taxes, assessments, water rate or insurance, as hereinafter provided.

Now, Know All Men, that the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said bond and for the better securing the payment of the said sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said bond, with the interest thereon, and also for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by the said Mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, convey and release unto the said Mortgagee and to its successors, legal representatives and assigns forever, all that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the north side of Knollwood Lane in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as the Western 35 feet of Lot 174 and all of lots 175 and 176 on plat of Cleveland Forest made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book M, page 137 and having according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. W. Dalton, Surveyor, February 19, 1948 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Knollwood Lane at joint front corner of Lots 176 and 177, said pin being 373 feet East from the Northeast corner of the intersection of Knollwood Lane and Dogwood Lane and running thence with the line of Lot 177, N. 20-41 W. 161.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 52-33 E. 120 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 72-15 E. 35.1 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot 174; thence through Lot 174, S. 22-09 E. 204.5 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Knollwood Lane in the front line of Lot 174; thence with Knollwood Lane, S. 69-23 W. 35 feet to an iron pin; thence still with Knollwood Lane, S. 72-27 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the north side of Knollwood Lane, S. 75-31 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
