That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, seld and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as lot # 4, as shown on plat of property of Nona H. Squires and being more particularly described, according to said plat as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Western side of Florida Avenue, 350 feet South of the intersection of Florida Avenue and Easley Bridge Road, which pin is the joint corner of lots # 3 and 4 and running thence with joint line of said lots, S. 71-00 W. 200 feet to a stake; thence S. 22-10 E. 50 feet to a stake, joint rear corner of lots 4 and 5; thence with joint line of said lots, N. 71-00 E. 200 feet to a stake on Florida Avenue; thence with Florida Avenue, N. 22-10 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
