is justly indebted to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagee, in the sum of Eighty-Five Hundred

(\$8500.00), lawful money of the United States which shall be legal tender in payment of all debts and dues, public and private, at the time of payment, secured to be paid by that one certain bond or obligation, bearing even date herewith, conditioned for payment at the principal office of the said C. Douglas Wilson & Co., in the City of Greenville, S. C., or at such other place either within or without the State of South Carolina, as the owner of this obligation may from time to time designate, of the sum of

Eighty-Five Hundred-----

-----Dollars (\$8500.00)

with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of 4 1/2 per centum per annum, said interest to be paid on the first day of May 1948 and thereafter said interest and principal sum to be paid in installments as follows: Beginning on the first day of June 1948, and on the first day of each month thereafter the sum of \$72.07 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the first day of April 1961, and the balance of said principal sum to be due and payable on the first day of May 1961; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$72.07 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of 4 1/2 per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$8500.00 or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal. Said principal and interest to be paid at the par of exchange and net to the obligee, it being thereby expressly agreed that the whole of the said principal sum shall become due after default in the payment of interest, taxes, assessments, water rate or insurance, as hereinafter provided.

Now, Know All Men, that the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said bond and for the better securing the payment of the said sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said bond, with the interest thereon, and also for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by the said Mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, convey and release unto the said Mortgagee and to its successors, legal representatives and assigns forever, all that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the North side of Cureton Street, in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 1 of Block "G", on Plat of property of W. W. Carter and Associates, made September 25, 1935, recorded in the A. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "H", Page 288 and having according to a survey made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, May 9, 1945, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Cureton Street, at joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2 of Block "G" and running thence with the line of Lot 2 N. 26-30 W. 155 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lots 14 and 15 S. 63-38 W. 120 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Mitchell Street; thence along the Northeast side of Mitchell Street and an unnamed street along a curved line to a point (the chord being S. 30-10 E. 40 feet); thence* continuing along the Northeast side of said unnamed street along a curved line to a point (the chord being S. 62-32 E. 40 feet); thence continuing with the Northern side of said unnamed street along a curved line to a point (the chord being S. 77-13 E. 40 feet); thence continuing along said unnamed street in a curved line to a point (the chord being N. 87-27 E. 50.8 feet) on the North side of Cureton Street, the beginning corner.
