All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in the block bounded by Hammett Street, Henry Street, Goldsmith Street and McKoy Street (formerly known as David Street) and West of the New Buncombe Road near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lots 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 101, 102, 103, 104 and 105 and the strip formerly shown as an alley on plat of H. P. Hammett Lands made by William F. Lee, June 3-18, 1903, recorded in the R. M. C.
